



Ans) The different ways in which living things breathe are as follows:

- Humans, cats, dogs, whales –They breathe through their nose. From the nose the air goes to the lungs.
- Fish- A fish breathe through its gills.
- Insects- Insects breathe through holes on the surface of their body called spiracles. Examples- cockroaches and flies.
- Plants breathe through tiny pores on their leaves called stomata.

Ans) a) Living things need food to live.

b) Food provides energy to the body and helps to grow.

Ans) A bus is a non living thing because they cannot move on their own, they can only move with our help. Also it doesn't show any other characteristics of living things.



Ans) The breaking down of food into small substances that the body can use is called digestion.

2) What are the body parts that are related to our circulatory system?

Ans) The heart, arteries and veins are the body parts that are related to our circulatory system.

3) What is the role of kidneys in our body?

Ans) The kidneys help in removing the liquid waste from the body in the form of urine.

F. Give detailed answers to the following questions:

1) What do you understand by inhalation and exhalation? Which part of the body helps us in this?

Ans) Inhalation- Lungs help in taking in oxygen in our body when we breathe in air through the nose. The lungs grow bigger or expand. This is called inhalation.

Exhalation- When we breathe out, the lungs contract and carbon dioxide rich air is thrown out of the nose. This is called exhalation.

Lungs help in this process of respiration.

2) Write the functions of the liver and skeletal system.

Ans) The functions of the liver and skeletal system are:

a) Liver- It helps in digesting the food. The bile produced by the liver digests fats by breaking food items like oil, butter into tiny droplets.

b) Skeletal system – They protect the soft and delicate organs of our body. They hold our body up and give it support and a firm shape.

3) How does the brain control our body functions?

Ans) The brain is the control centre of the body.

- a) The brain helps us to think and react to different situations.
 - b) It stores information in the form of a memory bank.
 - c) The brain receives the messages from the sense organs and sends out signals through thread like structures called nerves to different parts of the body.
- Our brain needs a continuous supply of blood and oxygen to function.

1) Why do we say that human body is like a machine?

Ans) Human body is like a machine because it works with the help of many parts i.e, internal organs and external organs. When we sleep, the external organs like hands, legs, eyes etc take rest. But the internal organs like heart, lungs, brain etc work all the time when we are asleep.
